AHEAD OF TIME: GROWING OLDER WITH HIV This booklet was developed by AFAO and NAPWA, in conjunction with ACON. It includes up-to-date information about HIV and the ageing process that is relevant to the lives and health of people living with and growing older with HIV.	
HIV TEST AND TREATMENTS This booklet describes the currently available antiviral drugs for the treatment and management of HIV infection. It also describes some common tests used to monitor the health of people with HIV, and how these tests can be used to help you look after your health, or make decisions about starting, stopping or changing antiviral treatments.	
NEWLY HIV+ BUSINESS CARDS These cards contain all the useful information and contacts for newly HIV+ people.	
MANAGING SIDE EFFECTS This booklet is intended as a guide only for people with HIV who experience side effects from HIV treatments or other physical symptoms that may be due to HIV infection.
