- Free condoms and lube will be accessible near areas like the darkroom.
- Information leaflets on sexual health, HIV and STIs and testing services will be available.
- Information leaflets will be accessible near areas with good lighting.

- Lighting is appropriate enough so you can read the resources available; find the free condoms and lube; staff can clean properly and so you can see where you are going.
